The majority of Brazilian ports is currently suffering from the strike impact.

Dear Customers,

Since the last March 18th, the Customs in Brazil started a national strike in which all 12 thousand auditors in the country paralyzed their activities. Only will be released, in ports and airports, stock live, perishable, explosives and flammable cargo, and medicines.

According to the union, each station has regional autonomy to decide which way to resume work, partially or not, considering the peculiarities of home region and the release of cargo is being analysed case by case.

The majority ports and airports of the country, as Guarulhos, Viracopos, Paranagua, Rio de Janeiro and Vitoria, also are operating only with the 30% staff required by law, causing queues and delays.

The Schenker offices are still fully operative and do handle ocean and air freight business with utmost attention but in consideration of mentioned facts.
